

## CAMPER AND PARENT AGREEMENT

- It is understood that Maine Arts Camp (MAC) is not responsible for articles of clothing or personal belongings lost or damaged by fire, theft, etc. MAC does not recommend campers bringing expensive clothing, cameras, jewelry, radios, electronics, etc.
- It is understood and agreed by campers and parent/guardians that a camper's use of drugs or drug paraphernalia, tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, and/or any illegal controlled substances, weapons, and/or violent behavior including teasing and hitting is not permitted and could be cause for immediate dismissal. There will be no refunds.
- It is understood that sneaking out of the dorms at night is unsafe and could result in immediate expulsion.
- I agree that MAC reserves the right to cancel, change or substitute programs or activities as listed on the activity sheet when necessary.
- I have received and read the Parent/Camper Handbook and understand and agree to follow all policies and procedures enclosed in it.
- I will not bring any dangerous or expensive goods to camp. Maine Arts Camp takes no responsibility for lost or broken equipment.
