How do I enroll my child(ren)? If enrolling before April 15, 2012, include a deposit of \$1000 with this application. The balance is due by April 15, 2012. If enrolling after April 15, then include the full payment. For families with more than one child, there is a 5% discount off of the total tuition.

Withdraws: Deposits are refundable until March 1, 2012 (less a \$150 processing fee). After March 1, 2012, deposits and payments are non-refundable. TravMark tuition insurance available—see our website.

Camper tuition includes: airport pickup and drop off at the Portland (Maine) Jetport or Bangor International Airport (for those campers flying to camp), laundry, all in camp activities, and most trip days.

Late fees: Any unpaid balances for campers registered, but not paid by April 15th will incur a late fee of 1% per month.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Rules and Regulations: The camper (“camper”) and parent(s) (“parent”) agree to abide by all of the rules and regulations established by Maine Arts Camp, LLC (“camp”) including, without limitation, those relating to enrollment and withdrawal of campers and visitation.

Dismissal of Camper: Enrollment at camp may be terminated at any time for the health, safety or welfare of the camper and/or the camp. No refunds will be made.

Permission to Participate: Parent grants camper permission to participate in all camp activities, excursions, and special outings and understands that accidents and injuries may occur in the natural course of participation in such activities.
