Maine Arts Camp's Specialty Week...years in the making, and it's finally here!

Campers who attend a two or four-week session will have the option of signing up for a one-week specialty camp at the end. During this week, campers will have the opportunity to focus on two activities, taking one for to 2 1/2 hours every morning, and another for 2 1/2 hours every afternoon. Then, they'll be able to choose from various electives to end each afternoon on the lighter side.

Specialty Week will allow campers to spend a total of 15 hours in each of these two activities. If you compare this to the six hours they spend in each activity during our regular two-week sessions, you can just imagine how much they can learn and accomplish during this week! If your child is serious about any one of the activities that we're offering during Specialty Week, this is the perfect opportunity to let them really blossom in that area.

It is possible to sign up for the Specialty Week after you've enrolled in a two or four-week session--if there's room. We will only accept about 80 campers for the Specialty Week, as opposed to our 150 maximum for the regular sessions. Also, certain workshops may fill up faster than others, so please be aware of that. You can sign up for the Specialty Week on our regular Camper Application, which is available on our web site.
